

SAMPLE letter to parents from teachers asking for completed medical

Dear Parents,

I am very fortunate to be working closely with Special Olympics New Jersey this school year. During recess the students will be participating in their program called Get Into Our Game to teach students the skills they need to successfully play team sports. We will begin by learning the techniques and rules of soccer (basketball, track & field), and students will have the opportunity to participate in a group every other day.

Special Olympics New Jersey provides us with the equipment we need for this program, and therefore, asks for you to get a medical form filled out for your child. As the children return the forms to school they will receive a Get Into Our Game t-shirt. We will also be holding a ceremony at the end of school at which time each child will receive their own soccer ball. If your child is already an athlete of Special Olympics there is no need to fill out a medical form, because New Jersey should have one on file.
