

## Class 28- Non-Independent Showmanship-like With Pattern and Inspection

The camera person stands at the Judge's marker and is the Judge/Judge's eyes. Judge gives the ok to the Handler to start. When the horse is set up for inspection, the camera person moves (to their left) around the horse, starting on the horse's right, in a circle slowly, like a judge would in an in-person show. The Handler should move in the half system crossover during inspection. Judge, during the walk around please ask the Handler two questions from below, your choice:

*What is your horse's name?*

*What color is your horse?*

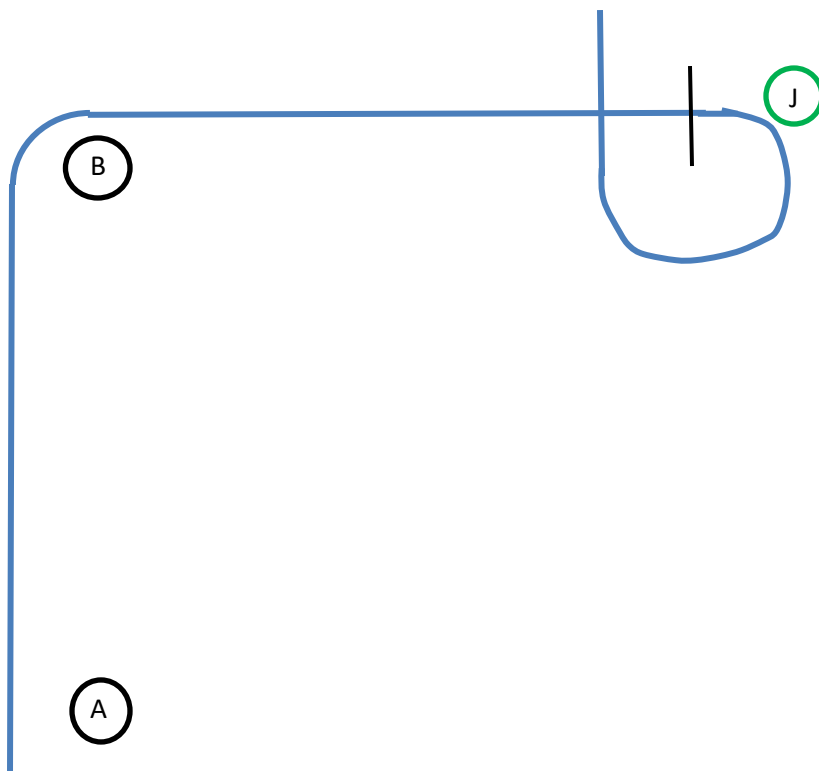
*What does your horse eat?*

*How old is your horse?*

*What breed is your horse?*

*Is your horse a mare or gelding?*

Dismiss the Handler after inspection.

- Wait for the Judge to give the OK to start.
- Walk from marker A to marker B
- Walk from marker B to the Judge.
- Stop and set up for inspection.
- When dismissed perform a right semi-circle and walk away from the Judge.

*At the Program/Coach's discretion, an assistant may be present and used to the capacity deemed appropriate. Points will not be deducted if an assistant is present but will be deducted if the assistant overtly controls the horse.*
